

PHASE III REOPENING OF TERRITORY'S BORDERS

We're continuing to work to get things ready for you to come to the BVI.

All travellers will need to log into our BVI Gateway at bvigateway.bviaa.com in order to register for your arrival.

Whether you are a resident or a non-resident of the British Virgin Islands, you will need to follow mostly the same steps. This applies whether you're staying at approved travel accommodations, on a vessel, or in home quarantine. Please do all use the site.

If you're requesting home quarantine, ensure that you begin the process ideally 7 days prior to arrival. This allows time for inspection of your home.

Get started by registering on the website and selecting "home quarantine" when asked. You may also call 1(284) 468-5110. Do enter your email address in the box provided. There will be a one-time password that will be sent to your email and this is in order to authenticate your account.

On receiving that password, enter it, and then proceed to fill in your personal information: your name, your date of birth, your passport number, your location—all of the information that is required for your travel, your quarantine, your health questions, as well as your immigration and customs information for arrival. Do so for yourself as well as your immediate family members.

Submit your application. Note that you need to proceed all the way through the website and complete all of the steps in order to submit and save your information, and that, in turn, begins our review process.

After review, you will be prompted to submit additional documents. At that point, log in again and upload a negative PCR test result, that test will be done by a medical laboratory that is certified and is performed, of course, within five days of your arrival to the BVI.

Do then provide your consent to a series of declarations.

On completion of all of these steps, and on successful review of your application, you will be prompted to then \$175 dollars for all of your COVID19 entry fees. At that point, you will receive your travel authorisation certificate and are welcome to come join us here in the BVI.

If you're a non-resident you are required during this process to have medical travel insurance that covers COVID-19 related costs. You will be prompted at the appropriate time.
